◎Internet fraud is not only on the rise, but it is accelerating. The variety of scams continues to develop in complexity and effectiveness, leaving the casual user ever more vulnerable to personal loss, while law enforcement appears to be mostly unprepared to handle the sudden and massive burden of new, difficult-to-investigate crimes. The best defense against crime, however, has remained unchanged since the dawn of civilization: personal responsibility and preparation. Below are the top three scams, but there are far more than these.

Lottery Winnings: Emails claiming that the recipient has won money generate enough excitement to cloud a person's judgment. They may ask for cash to cover the taxes before the money can be released, the taxes are the winner's responsibility to pay after the money is received, and are only paid to the winner's government. They may also request bank account numbers for a wire transfer.

Undelivered Auction Goods: Beware of extended slipping delays when purchasing anything online. A purchaser is protected from fraud for a short time -- usually only two to four weeks. If a seller succeeds in delaying past this time, then the buyer has no recourse if the item is never sent.

masquerading as an authentic entity. For example, an email that looks like it came from PayPal.com says that your account has been accessed by an unknown party. It asks you to follow the link to log in and identify any account activity that you did not authorize. ◎ Ponzi and pyramid schemes are both investment frauds. They both involve deceiving others by promising substantial income or returns on an investor's initial investment. Unlike a regular investment, these schemes can offer consistent profits only as long as the number of investors continues to increase. Once the number tapers off, so does the money. But there are inherent differences between the two.

The investment manager of a Ponzi scheme will promise you substantially higher returns than any traditional investment with little to no risk. Investment strategies are often too complicated to understand and you may not receive any financial documents. The "returns" actually come from the incoming funds contributed by later investors.

Pyramid schemes similarly offer big returns for little investment capital. However, they require individuals to pay an entrance fee and/or purchase products/services in order to participate. These people are then required to bring in more people to the scheme. People at the top are paid the most, receiving a portion of the money that the new recruits contribute. Those at the bottom of the pyramid make little to nothing, especially when no new individuals are recruited. [112 警持 四]

The Impact of Unaccounted-for Foreign Workers on Public Order and Security (下落不明的外籍勞工對公共秩序和安全的影響) 【108警特三】 參考答案:

Though foreign workers serve to overcome the labor shortage in Taiwan's market, over-dependence on foreign workers has created a serious social problem. The main negative impacts induced by foreign workers include over-dependence on foreign laborers, language barrier, and exploitation of illegal foreign laborers. (43字)

For starters, why can't we give more opportunities to local workers but instead we have to bring in a lot of workers from abroad? Apart from the alarming issue of low employment rate among college graduates in the wake of the sluggish economy, the law enforcement has to deal with the innumerable runaway foreign workers, which has unsurprisingly turned into one of the country's biggest headaches. On the economic front, the existence of the numerous unaccounted-for foreign workers has substantially compromised the balance of Taiwan's manpower market, poaching jobs from native Taiwanese workers. On top of that, away from the supervision of the authorities concerned, un-accounted-for foreign workers have posed a potential threat to the public order and security of our society. (122字)

Secondly, the language barrier between locals and foreign workers is likely to create racism—an issue impossible to be solved by the police alone. Language is like an unbridgeable barrier for foreign workers, impeding their interaction with local workers and creating factions in workplaces. Tension is often seen when they experience racism and harassment. They will lose temper easily and engage in serious verbal, if not physical, conflicts. In addition, whenever the police arrest illegal foreign workers, they will deny cooperating with police officers by pretending to be illiterate. Ironically, they are very good at taking advantage of the loophole. (100字)

Last but not least, following the issue of runaway workers is the concern of labor exploitation that would almost inevitably ensue as another headache for law enforcement agencies. Without identifications but with the desire to earn as much money as possible during their illegal stay in Taiwan, they fall easy prey to deceitful employers who would utilize and treated unfairly for their own benefits. This is common situation and remains largely unscrutinized. (72字)

The Impact of Unaccounted-for Foreign Workers on Public Order and Security Measures Against Transnational Telecom Fraud. [106警研所]

Telecom-based fraud is a new type of crime in which suspects cheat people through the use of telecommunication channels. The crimes are becoming more prevalent in China's certain regions in recent years. In order to get rid of the rampant criminal activities, some measures need to be done immediately:

First off, strengthen cooperation across the Strait. The networks primarily targeted mainlanders and Taiwan residents. They often organized a telecom-based swindling group and set up a telecommunications fraud network throughout the Chinese mainland, Taiwan, the Philippines, Thailand, Indonesia and Vietnam, etc. To proactively look into overseas telecommunications fraud cases involving Taiwanese suspects and Chinese victims, a long-standing systematic model can be established to deal with similar cases through negotiations with China which can provide information and methodologies to facilitate investigations into such cases in the hope of strengthening cross-strait mechanisms for combating crime.

Furthermore, pass more strict laws and fight against it globally. The Ministry of Justice and the Criminal Investigation Bureau under the Ministry of the Interior should continue to ask China for evidence on the cases to facilitate investigations. Request relevant government agencies to assess the feasibility of revising fraud laws amid mounting calls for tougher punishment of convicted suspects and mutually exchanges evidence through judicial assistant overseas so as to charge the criminals effectively. Law enforcement cooperation among authorities on the Chinese mainland, Taiwan and ASEAN countries is also a key factor in uncovering transnational telecom swindling rings. The joint crackdown among the Chinese mainland, Taiwan and ASEAN countries has further consolidated the cooperative basis among them and broadened the fields and areas for further cooperation.

In addition to making arrests and traffic stops, officers often mediate disputes, domestic and otherwise. Mediation requires skill in listening, persuasion, conflict management, and the ability to subdue a **belligerent** person if needed. When responding to an incident, there is often far more involved than an arrest. Officers must first investigate and decide which, if any, crime was committed, and by whom. This requires problem solving, analytical ability, and knowledge of investigative techniques, as well as a good memory and observational skills.

Another core job duty is documenting investigations and incidents. The documentation is required to create a record and may be used in criminal or court proceedings. As a result, officers must attend to detail, have strong writing skills, and be able to use word processing software. There are other skills that may not come to mind as quickly. Yet, these skills are helpful, or may even be essential. For example, law enforcement officers are often the first to arrive at the scene of an accident. Thus,knowledge of CPR and first-aid are essential. Or, consider the ability to speak a second language, which can be very helpful in interviewing victims and witnesses. [ 106 新所 ]

The use of force is a double-edged sword for the police. Used properly, force can help bring criminals to justice. On the contrary, excessive or poor force use may lead to the criticisms of state violence or public servants' inertia. What are the keys to area reasonable and justifiable use of force? The frequency of police use-of-force events that may be defined as justified or excessive is difficult to estimate. Broadly speaking, the use of force by law enforcement officers becomes necessary and is permitted under specific circumstances, such as in self-defense or in defense of another individual or group. The keys to a reasonable and justifiable use of force are as followed:

First of all. No two situations are the same, nor are any two officers. Situational awareness is essential, and officers are trained to judge when a crisis requires the use of force to regain control of a situation. In most cases, time becomes the key variable in determining when an officer chooses to use force.

Secondly, amount of force used should be alert. Law enforcement officers should use only the amount of force necessary to mitigate an incident, make an arrest, or protect themselves or others from harm. The levels, or continuum, of force police use include basic verbal and physical restraint, less-lethal force, and lethal force.

Last but not the least, learn more about the use-of-force continuum. The level of force an officer uses varies based on the situation. Because of this variation, guidelines for the use of force are based on many factors, including the officer's level of training or experience.

An officer's goal is to regain control as soon as possible while protecting the community. Use of force is an officer's last option — a necessary course of action to restore safety in a community when other practices are ineffective. Injuries may occur in any use-of-force incident, and police should ensure that those injured receive medical aid and that the family of any injured person is notified.

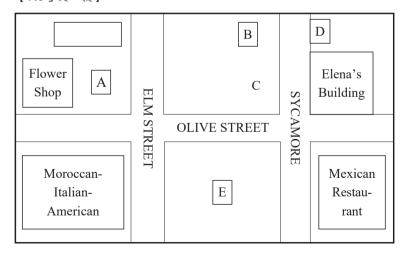

In recent times there has been a lot of discussion about bilingual education in areas where most residents are not native English speakers. According to many reports in the media, the war between pros and cons of bilingual education among non-native English speakers is a war between rational people who think people should acquire English and irrational fanatics who think the current generation should be prevented from learning English. As far as I am concerned, I do propose bilingual education among non-native English speakers. Here are my personal advice.

First of all, it is not only easier for students to learn English if they are literate in their first language, but that such students will learn English better and become bilingual and biliterate.

Secondly, most of the countries in the world use English as a tool of communication. Therefore, as for areas in which English is not taken as their first language, no matter where one goes and whatever what one does, he almost can't do without the ability to speak some basic and useful English. Besides, the latest first-hand information on technology, business and what not are printed in English. To catch up with the world, if we could promote bilingual education in Taiwan, chances are better than those who do not have bilingual sections.

Last but not least, effective bilingual programs strive to achieve proficiency in both English and the non-native speakers home language. The teacher instructs in English and in the English language learners' (ELLs) home language with a view to teaching the students a new language and culture, and language diversity. Programs in English only eradicate the native languages immigrants bring to this country, while dual language bilingual programs serve to maintain such languages in an "additive" context, where a new language is added without the first being lost

#### (案例1.)

One paper states that two-way developmental bilingual education programs among non-mother-tongue speakers have the most success in language minority students' long term academic achievement. These students will maintain their gains in academic performance in secondary level academic classes.

#### (案例2.)

Another study shows the positive results of a two-way bilingual education program. Some people make the mistake that once a student can converse in English (Basic interpersonal communication skills, BICS), they will naturally perform well academically (cognitive academic language proficiency, CALP) in English. It has been postulated that BICS and CALP are two different sets of skills. Debates around bilingual education are as much political as they are pedagogical. Though it's not easy to master a language, importance of bilingual education among non-native English speakers cannot be overemphasized in a global village. For our own good, bilingual education is worth popularizing among.

# ◎Write an essay on the following topic: <u>Information technology in policing and</u> its impacts. [101 警大碩班]

#### 參考答案:

Technological innovation has served as the catalyst for dramatic changes in the organization of police work and has presented both opportunities and challenges to police and other criminal justice practitioners. The placement of Information Technology (IT) is widely seen as one of the most important technological developments to occur in policing in recent years.

IT has the potential to change and improve police practices and performance in various ways. For example, computer-aided dispatch systems can be used to better manage the deployment of police vehicles and make police patrol activities more information-driven. Well-designed information systems can also facilitate the apprehension and detection of offenders by increasing the range and timeliness of information that investigators can access, by providing analytical tools that can be used to profile suspects and identify offending patterns, and by making it easier to identify and track repeat offenders. In addition, information technology can substantially assist problem-oriented policing activities by aiding in the identification of problem areas and addresses, by highlighting trends and patterns that warrant attention by police and other agencies and by allowing information to be shared by agencies.

Implementing such systems, however, involves a host of challenges, ranging from acceptance by established bureaucracies to privacy and security concerns to practical questions like how to pay for them. Besides, some people are concerned that police had become too reliant on technology for information. These officers lamented the loss of local knowledge and the retreat from hands-on methods for gathering intelligence. Furthermore, IT did not appear to have changed the dominant style of policing. Few thought that information technology had led to a more problem-oriented police service or better proactive policing. Some even suggested that the potential for smarter policing strategies was frustrated by the lack of time and resources and the inappropriate use of intelligence officers.

IT have indeed made a great difference to police work and allowed police to work more effectively, made their work easier, improved police service to the public and helped them cope with the amount of information police needed to do their work properly. No technology, except IT, provides magic tools for solving complicated problems like crime. Thus, attention to the utilization and practice of IT in the field may provide helpful guidance for policymakers as they consider moving ahead in this promising area.
